- Glockenspiel (Glock.):** Provides a steady beat, marked *f*.
- Piano (Pno.):** Provides a steady accompaniment, marked *f*.
- Guitar (Gtr.):** Provides a steady accompaniment, marked *C* and *Am*.
- Ukulele (Uke.):** Provides a steady accompaniment, marked *C* and *Am*.
- Advanced Violin (Adv. Vln.):** Plays a melodic line, marked *p*.
- Intermediate Violin (Int. Vln.):** Provides a harmonic accompaniment, marked *p*.
- Elementary Violin (E. Vln.):** Provides a harmonic accompaniment, marked *p*.
- Viola (Vla.):** Provides a harmonic accompaniment, marked *p*.
- Cello (Clo.):** Provides a harmonic accompaniment, marked *p*.
- Bass (Bs.):** Provides a harmonic accompaniment, marked *p*.
